CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

No: GYC/13/102010/PRV102007/2160/A :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Archaeological Chemist, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Archaeology, namely :-

1. These Rules may be called the Assistant Archaeological Chemist (Directorate of Archaeology), Class III, Recruitment Rules, 2010.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Archaeological Chemist, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Archaeology shall be made either -
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who -
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Laboratory Assistant, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Archaeology; and
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above;

or

- (b) by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall -
 - (a) not be more than 30 years of age;
 - (b) possess -
 - (i) a second class degree of B.Sc. (Chemistry) obtained from Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government;
 - (ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

- (c) (i) have about two years experience on the post not below the rank of Laboratory Assistant, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Archaeology; or
- (ii) have about two years experience as Laboratory Assistant in a chemical laboratory in the Government or Government undertaking Board or Corporation or in Local Bodies or University or Limited Company established by Law in India or Hospital or private or public sector organization;
- (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that preference may be given to a candidate who has undergone a six months training at National Research Laboratory for the Conservation of Cultural Property (N.R.L.C.), Lucknow or in a recognized institution as may be prescribed by the Government.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
6. The selected candidate shall require to undergo a six months training at National Research Laboratory for the Conservation of Culture Property (N.R.L.C.), Lucknow or in a recognized institution as may be prescribed by the Government.
7. The selected candidate shall require to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
