CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GYC/2/2010/ SHL/102006/901/A .- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the I post of Assistant Curator, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Museums, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Curator, Class III, Recruitment Rules, 2010.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Curator, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Museums shall be made by direct selection;
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule-2, a candidate
 - (a) not be more than 30 years of age ;
 - (b) possess,-
 - (i) a degree obtained from any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated or under the Central or State Act in India or any other Educational Institution recognized or declared as deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, with any one of the following subjects, namely;
 - (i) History (ii) Ancient Indian History and Culture (iii) Archeology (iv) Fine Arts- Arts (v) Painting (vi) Geology (vii) Zoology (viii) Anthropology (ix) Chemistry (x) (xi) any Indian classical Language; and
 - (ii) a post-graduate Diploma or post graduate degree in Museology obtained from any Universities or institution established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other Educational Institution recognized as such or declared as deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or post equivalent qualification recognized by the Government; and
 - (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
 - (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and / or Hindi:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass a qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the provision of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
6. The selected candidate shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules as prescribed by the Government.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass an examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time .
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government.
